

The Cormier Family: Reaching the Deaf of Kenya With The Gospel of Christ

Dear Pastors, Supporters, and Praying Friends,

Greetings from Kenya! During the last two months, the Lord has blessed the ministry here, and we would like to update you on what is going on.

In June, missionary Billy Coley and I started a Bible Institute at Karen Baptist Church. In recent years, we've been blessed with a large group of young men who faithfully attend our church. Although many of these youth are still in school, several of them are graduated, and these have expressed a desire to learn the Word of God. In the Bible Institute on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, I teach Homiletics and Personal Evangelism, and on Thursdays, Bro. Coley teaches Bible Doctrines. On Wednesday afternoons, we and our students go soul-winning in Embulbul, the local community near our church. God has greatly blessed our efforts as we tell others about Him. After soul-winning on Wednesdays, we return to the classroom where I teach New Testament Epistles and the History of Music. On Wednesday nights, more people join our classes once they get off work.

Last month, during evangelism, we met several people who expressed interest in learning more about the gospel. In Kenya, people often express a willingness to begin a Bible study in their homes. The Bible students and I are currently teaching the Gospel Seed lessons to three people in Embulbul. Nelson is a guard who works at an apartment complex, Emily is a mother of three, and Faith is a lady who actually prayed to receive Christ the day we met her. Faith said that my wife had also witnessed to her on another occasion. Evidently, since that time, the Holy Spirit had been working in Faith's heart, and when we met her that day, she was ready. Even though she is now a Christian, she wants to be taught the Gospel Seed lessons as well.

In August, we have a full schedule planned. Not only will I teach Bible College classes in Nakuru, we will also hold a week-long youth seminar at Karen Baptist Church because our young people will be on school break. We usually have a good turnout for youth seminars, and some of those who attend are not yet saved. Please pray with us concerning both of these ministries which will take place next month.

Our family is planning to go on furlough in June of 2024. If you would like us to visit your church, please contact me at my e-mail address: boundforkenya@gmail.com.
