In that text message, Wilson told me that he wanted to be saved but wasn't sure how. Wilson lives two and a half hours away from us, so I sent him transportation money, and he visited our home. For about four hours that afternoon, I thoroughly went through the plan of salvation with him. He remembered quite a bit from the many lessons that we've had together. At the end, when I asked him if he understood and was ready to be saved, Wilson gave his heart to Jesus Christ. What a joy that was to my heart!

Now Wilson's wife, Peris, has asked to be taught about salvation. She is also Deaf. Please be much in prayer for her. Because they were recently married, I have not had the opportunity to teach her like I taught Wilson, so this will take time. Also because they live so far away, I am looking into options of how I can teach Peris via technology. Without a current driver's license, I cannot make weekly trips to Naivasha like I did before with Wilson. We covet your prayers that God will give us wisdom in how we can teach Peris the Gospel so that she can be saved as well.

In recent weeks, we saw two more souls come to know Christ. Twice a week during the month of December, we hosted special youth meetings at our home. The plan was to teach the Gospel Seed lessons to the young people of our church before they returned to school in January. Our young people really enjoyed the time they spent together, and God blessed our efforts. As a result of these meetings, two teenage boys were saved. Please pray for Sammy and Mark that they will grow in their newfound faith.

Our paperwork seems to be at a standstill right now. I've heard nothing from the government offices of late, so we continue to wait and pray. Thank you for your continued prayers in this regard.

As a family, we want to thank you for all of the cards and gifts that you sent to us during the Christmas season. We greatly appreciate your love and prayers for our family as we continue to serve the Lord here in Kenya.
