January-February Prayer Letter

Dear Pastors, Supporters, and Praying Friends,

Greetings once again from Kenya. We hope this letter finds you well as you continue to serve the Lord in the place where He has you.

In January classes resumed in the Bible institute. This term my students and I are studying World Missions, Expository Bible Teaching, Bible Doctrines III, New Testament Epistles, and Music. The men are doing well, and they continue to grow in their preaching.

Things are also going well with the KSL II class. We are currently training three Kenyan men to be interpreters as well as our two oldest children—Seth and Brina. In February the KSL students each interpreted a song at a church, and they did well with it. They will continue to develop their interpreting skills with occasional hymns in church while also learning to interpret for a speaker during the announcements. In class I am also teaching them how to effectively share the gospel with the Deaf. In a few weeks, we will conclude KSL II with the students participating in a mock soul-winning engagement. In this exercise, their sign language skills as well as their Bible knowledge will be thoroughly tested.

On February 5th after much prayer and many visits to see government officials, our work permit was finally approved, issued, and applied. I had submitted the paperwork last August, so this time it took about six months. Please continue to pray for us in regards to our paperwork because our daughters still need dependent's passes. We have been trying to get those since Shanna was born.

In April when Kenyan schools go on break, we are planning to hold another youth seminar for the young people of our church. In addition to that, I will help teach another week-long session at the Rift Valley Baptist College. Please pray with us concerning these upcoming events.

In August of this year, our family will be going on furlough, so I have begun scheduling meetings. After spending some time with family, we will begin traveling in September. If you would like us to visit your church, please contact me at boundforkenya@gmail.com.
